Reminders: 3D Printing Project Requirements

Project must not exceed a build space of 110mm x 110mm x 110mm AND take less than 10 hours to print.

(Please note: This is the hard limit of what is possible, not just a rule.)

The Library's 3D printer may be used for lawful purposes only. The public will not be permitted to use the Library's 3D printer to create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state, or federal law.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others (Such use may violate the terms of use of the manufacturer)
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the Library environment
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printer will not be used to reproduce a material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection.

How to Submit your Project:

1. Complete this form and email it to Moriah Churchill at mchurchill@newport.lib.nh.us

2. Attach your project file to your email. Acceptable formats include: **.stl**

OR Include the link to the project you found on the "Thingiverse" at <https://www.thingiverse.com/>

Notice: We will need to "slice" the project file using CURA software at the library. During this stage, we may need to make adjustments to your project to ensure correct printing or printing at an optimal scale.
